## Suggestion by the Chairman:

- The faculty should enforce students for maximum participation in skill development programmes.

- The achievements of national / state level competitions / exhibitions can also be displayed on posters in labs to motivate students and for publicity.

Department wise presentations

- 2) Suggestions by Dr. Krishnamoorthy:

  - Encourage students to clear GATE in 3<sup>rd</sup> year itself so that they can get a higher placement package. Mark GATE syllabus in the University syllabus so that students / faculty get trained in those topics.
  - When a rank / achievement is presented, more details like number of participants, their topic, etc. to be included.
  - Timeline to be set for all activities planned.
  - Presentation to be made more detailed with a view to NAAC presentation.

# C) Civil Engg. Department (Presented by Mr. Shreeshail Heggond)

- 1) Suggestions by the Chairman:
  - Plan industrial visit to CIDCO, Metro Project, site of slabs on Ghodbunder Road. The 3<sup>rd</sup> year Diploma students can also be included in the visit.
  - Mr. Namdev Patil to take details from Chairman about the Vasai person working in Mumbai Metro at a higher post and approach him for placement / internship of Civil / Mechanical students.
  - Details of all student achievement to be included in the presentation.
  - Timeline to be prepared for future plans.
  - Students' attendance should be 100% for all STEP programmes.
